



Description of the University Hospital of Berne

The University Hospital of Berne is situated in Berne, the capital town of Switzerland. With its time-honoured sandstone buildings, historic towers and unique fountains, Berne is one of the finest examples of mediaeval architecture in Europe. The city's appearance has remained virtually unchanged for centuries, earning Berne a place on the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites.

At the University Hospital of Berne, around 7500 people are working for a professional patient care. 38 clinics and institutions are summarized in 9 departments at the hospital. In 2012, over 38 000 patients were treated on the wards, and around 295 000 patients at the outpatient clinics. There is a nursing development and research department established at the University Hospital, which supports optimizing nursing care and patient outcomes. This and many other factors contribute to the fact that patients and employees are more satisfied with care or conditions of employment at the University Hospital of Berne, compared with the Swiss national average.



Focused on the department of urology, it consists of 3 wards (45 patients), an intermediate care unit (5 patients), an outpatient clinic, 4 operating rooms and a stone treatment center. One of the main interest lies in urological oncology. In 2013, the department of urology, became the first certified Prostate Cancer Center in Switzerland. Looking to the past, the orthotopic ileal neobladder (Studer-bladder), was developed in this department and is currently used worldwide. This technique show a low complication rate and excellent post-operative results.

Who decide to visit the Department of Urology at Berne will get the opportunity to be involved in the whole treatment und nursing process. You will have the possibility to observe, how we plan nursing care from the admission to the discharge of the patient and get insight in the operation theatre. Further nursing specialties are offered for patients:

- Advanced Practice Nurse Consulting for patients with prostate cancer and their partners
- Consulting of patients with an ileal bladder, Neobladder or Pouch
- Urostomy Care by specialized nurses
- Continence training of patients after radical prostatectomy by a nurse
- Education for patients who have to learn intermittent self – catheterization
