# **Description of Hospital / Institution**

The Ghent University Hospital is one of the largest and most specialized hospitals in Flanders with more than 3,000 patients a day and more than 6,000 employees. Patients are offered a wide range of top referent care. The hospital has extensive facilities and more than 1,000 beds for single-day and multi-day inpatient stays.

As a university medical center, Ghent University Hospital also invests in research, education and training and works closely together with the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences of Ghent University. The latter offers a wide range of study programmes in medicine and health sciences, as well as the associated research activities.

The urology department consists of an outpatient clinic and a urology ward for adults and a ward for children. Urology has daily operating schedules in the central operating rooms.

The whole range of urological care is provided at best quality levels. The hospital employs 7 professors in urology, and acts as a training centre for urologists. The specific fields of interest of the professors are: stone management, onco-urology, reconstructive urology, functional urology and specialised pediatric urology.

If you visit our hospital, we can offer you a general programme, where you can visit the different services, we can offer you a programme focused on a specific group of patients, or focused on a specific pathology.

Most of the nursing staff speaks Dutch (of course) and English.

As our hospital is a training centre for students in nursing, we have a tradition in mentoring new people. You're always welcome.
